## COMBI-WAX

A revolutionary surface treatment that improves performance.

Combi-Wax is an equestrian surface treatment renowned for its ability to improve ground performance making the riding experience better for both the horse and rider. Combi-Wax has been developed exclusively for Combi-Ride alongside one of the world's leading equestrian wax companies, making the properties of the wax based emulsion, stay structured within the surface to reduce the need to add water. Combi-Wax emulsion assists the riding surface to remain structured to reduce the need to add water for indoor and outdoor arenas. The wax, sand and fibre bind together to produce a stabilised and consistent surface. Combi-Wax enhances ride quality and stability without locking together, ensuring the riding surface does not get too hard. Combi-wax can be added to any waxed or non-waxed sand and fibre surfaces to save the need and cost of replacing your existing surface. When added to Combi-Ride fibre surfaces or other sand and fibre arenas the expert combination of materials also prevents dust making for a low maintenance surface overall.

Combi-Wax has been developed to have less environmental impact because it has a very low oil content and reduces excess oils that are washed off by the rain or other water that falls on the surface. It also requires less water when maintaining the surface, therefore water consumption is kept to a minimum.
